Lieutenant Colonel Damien T. Johnson is the Commander, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 800, The University of Tennessee, Knoxville. As professor and Department Chair of Aerospace Studies, he commands a diverse unit of officer, enlisted, and university employees to recruit, educate, train, and commission officer candidates through the AFROTC program and its affiliated crosstown school.

Lt Col Johnson was commissioned in 2006 as a graduate of the University of Tennessee ROTC program. In his previous flying assignments, Lt Col Johnson served in multiple Major Commands at the squadron, group, and wing levels. In his previous staff assignments, he performed various strategy planning and guidance duties at United States Air Forces Europe-Africa (USAFE) and Air Forces Central Command (AFCENT). Prior to this assignment, he served as the Director of Operations for the 5th Combat Training Squadron, USAFE



Warfare Center. In this capacity he helped lead USAFE's only live, virtual, and constructive training portfolios for U.S. and NATO fighter aircrews, tactical air controllers, command & control units, and MQ-9 operators.

Lt Col Johnson is a Senior Weapon System Officer with over 2,000 flight hours and has served as an Instructor and Flight Examiner in the B-1B and T-1A. He has operational experience in Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and NEW DAWN and over 1,000 combat hours.
